Our GP may provide you with a script for some medications. However we do not keep medications on site and you will have to get any script filled at your local pharmacy, at your cost.

Clinic 35



Our clinic

Clinic 35 provides information, support, clinical services and appropriate specialist referral for issues about:

- Sexually transmitted infections, including screening
- Sexually transmitted infection treatment
- Contraception
- Counselling
- Free condoms
- Emergency contraception
- Pregnancy testing
- Unplanned pregnancy counselling and referral
- Pap smears
- Breast checks
- Blood borne virus screening, counselling and referral
- Contact tracing
- Referral to specialist services i.e. termination of pregnancy , HIV/Hep C treatment
- Needle & Syringe Program.

Who works at Clinic 35

When you visit Clinic 35, you will be assessed by a registered nurse with specialised training in sexual and reproductive health. Together you can decide the best service for your needs. In some cases, the nurse may refer you to see your own GP, or alternatively refer you to other specialist services including our GP service.

Clinic 35 also has a dedicated health promotion team that aims to improve the sexual and reproductive health of young and marginalised people in our community.



Opening Hours

Clinic 35 is open Monday to Friday. If you want to see the nurse at Clinic 35 you can phone ahead to make an appointment, or alternatively from Monday to Wednesday you can walk in and wait to be seen. We will do our best to see you on any given day. However we may refer you to a GP or ask you to return depending on clinic availability.

After hours appointments may also be available on request.
